There is a need for teachers to directly connect with their students during remote learning. At the same time this schedule was developed with an interest in being thoughtful of student screen time and the length of their day tied to their computer. This schedule provides flexibility for students completing asynchronous (live) instruction along with providing them asynchronous support they can access during the school day.

During synchronous instruction, students are in a remote learning environment; the teacher is delivering real time instruction via Microsoft Teams to the whole class, small groups of students, or individual students.

During asynchronous learning and support, students are in a remote learning environment; the teacher has pre-developed or recorded lessons the students complete when convenient for the student/family and complete learning tasks based on pre-developed or recorded lessons.

Prior to Wednesday's asynchronous learning, teachers will communicate expectations and instructions to students.
